Individuals: this field is optional and consists of 12 digits. Businesses: if the recipient is a Russian legal entity, this field is mandatory and consists of 10 digits. If the recipient is a foreign legal entity, this field is mandatory and consists of 5 digits or 10 digits, depending on whether or not the foreign legal entity conducts business in Russia.	123456789012 1234567890

When filling out the Account number field and it calls for an IBAN number, please check with your recipient first or reference formats at official IBAN site: <https://www.iban.com/structure.html>

IBAN formatting requirements change from time to time and more new countries adopt the IBAN format. We'll prompt you to update the IBAN account number if this happens.

Required information	Description or format	Example
IBAN	Two-character country code, followed by two check digits and up to 31 alphanumeric characters for the bank account number.	Costa Rica: CR23015108410026012345
