PROGRAM DETAILS

In our Healthcare IT Certification Training, you'll get to choose your path for certification through either a Healthcare or a Technical focus. Both paths cover medical office procedures & administration and Healthcare IT certification basics. The healthcare-focused path concentrates on Electronic Health Records and CompTIA A+ certification and prepares you for the CEHRS and A+ exams. Whereas the more technical path is focused on CompTIA A+ and Network+ certifications. Students will choose their focus upon enrollment and will only take the two exams pertaining to their pathway.

After completing our program, you'll be prepared to pass the A+ exam and either the Network+ or Certified Electronic Health Records Specialist (CEHRS) exams.

CERTIFICATION ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Each certification body has its own eligibility requirements. Please make yourself familiar with these before applying for national certification testing. MedCerts sponsors certification but it is up to the student to ensure they meet eligibility requirements. CompTIA requires students be at least 13 years old to test. The National Healthcareer Association requires students be at least 18 years old and must provide proof of a high school diploma or equivalent and approved training/work experience to test. Additionally, the NHA allows students to take their certification exam up to 5 years after MedCerts program completion. Students have access to their MedCerts training materials for one (1) year after program completion.

EXPERIENTIAL/CLINICAL COMPONENT:

Experiential/Clinical Component Requirements (not a requirement for the Healthcare IT Technician program) – Once students complete this program, they will be able to immediately start working with Career Services at MedCerts.

CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECKS AND DRUG SCREENING POLICY:

MedCerts does not perform criminal background checks, nor do we test students for illicit drug use. Please be advised that while MedCerts does not perform these checks, the student's drug, criminal, or immunization status may prevent clinical/externship placement and future employment as a healthcare or IT professional. Externship sites, employers, and State Boards of Pharmacy or other regulatory boards have regulations about immunizations, drug use, and criminal backgrounds. Regulatory boards, externship sites, employers, and other organizations that may require these screenings for placement, and adverse results may prohibit you from moving forward in the program. Candidates with a felony conviction are not eligible to participate in ANY MedCerts program that includes the Pharmacy Technician certification as a primary or secondary certification.

The student understands that MedCerts does not hold any control over the drug, immunization, criminal, or background screening processes or policies held by any organization outside of MedCerts.



Upon 100% completion of this program, students will receive a "MedCerts Certificate of Completion." This is proof of completion of training but isn't a nationally recognized certification. Students are expected to take and pass the national certification exam through the issuing authority for recognized certification in their field.
