Intro to the Trades Dual Credit Pathway

This partnership between Medicine Hat Public School Division, Grasslands School Division and the Medicine Hat College will provide up to 24 high school students access to a year-long opportunity to learn about 7 different areas of focus in the trades.

- 24 seats - students apply to the program
- On MHC campus 7 times per year on 7 different topics (Sept - April) + intro module
- Pre-learning - approximately 5 hours per module online
- 1 Friday per month (typically PD days - official schedule TBA)

Please note - in the first year of this program we are accepting students from across grade levels to ensure program viability. This means that students do not have to commit to 3 years of programming (though the option is there for successful students):
