Test Requirements and Duration:

Procedures and requirements	Duration
1. <u>Dynamic risk assessment prior to work</u> Conduct dynamic risk assessment on worksite environment, equipment and tools, materials and safety equipment prior to work, including identification of potential hazards and taking countermeasures to ensure that potential hazards are eliminated and/or risks are reduced before commencement of work.	5 minutes
2. <u>Preparation prior to work and protection to work site</u> Review the worksite delivered by the person-in-charge / worker of the previous work process, and perform proper protection as well as appropriate preparations before commencement of work according to the worksite environment and the conditions of the workpiece etc.	5 minutes
3. <u>Practical Test</u> Carry out the works in accordance with the requirements, specifications and working drawing, and complete the specified works at the designated locations.	3 hours

Test Content

1. Select the correct adhesive and fix the glass wool insulation pins securely.
2. Install glass wool insulation to the specified rectangular duct sections and air grille.
3. Seal the air duct inspection door using leak-proof rubber to ensure airtightness.
4. Complete the thermal insulation of the chilled water pipe at Section A using the specified insulation materials and sealant.
5. Complete the thermal insulation of the refrigerant pipe at Section F using the specified insulation materials and joint sealant.
6. Maintain good housekeeping and leave the work area in a clean and tidy condition.

Test Requirements and Duration:

Procedures and requirements	Duration
4. <u>Housekeeping after work and final touch-up on work before handover</u> After completion of work, clean and tidy up the worksite, equipment, tools and materials, and review the quality of workpiece taking into account of the possible impact on the upcoming work process. The finished workpiece should be properly handled in preparation for delivery along with the worksite.	5 minutes

Note:

- Candidates should read the attached “Notes to Candidate” before commencement of work and comply with all test related rules and requirements.
- Practical test assessment framework is comprised of “Technical Assessment” and “Dynamic Risk Assessment and Safety Practice Assessment”. Candidates must fulfil the passing requirements for both assessment parts to achieve an overall “Pass” grade in the practical test.

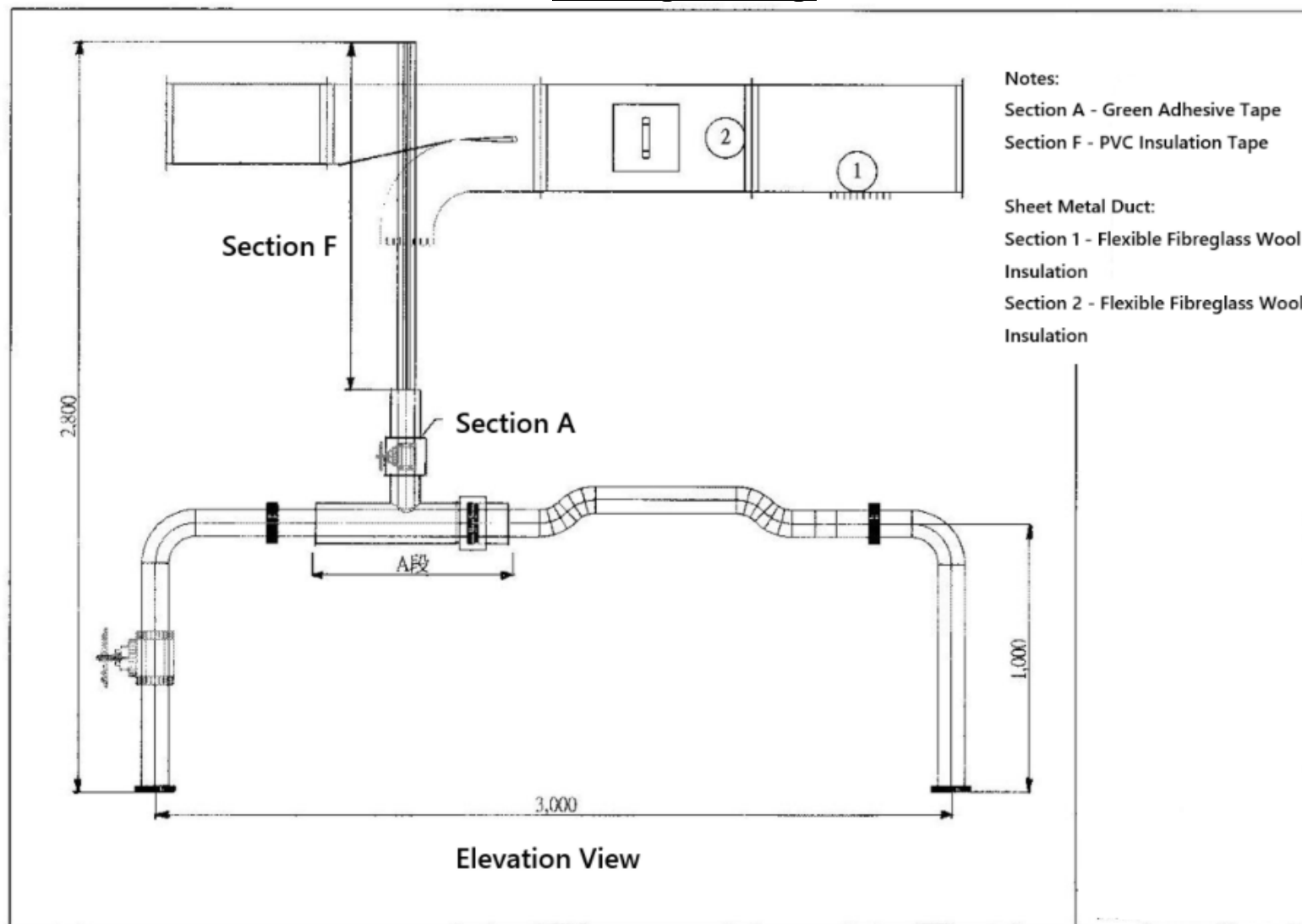

Notes to Candidate

1. Candidates should read the test papers carefully and ask the invigilator for any queries.
2. The practical test making scheme is based on the following criteria:
 - a. Understanding of drawing and specification
 - b. Preparation work before commencement of test
 - c. Working procedures, accuracy and quality of work
 - d. Proper handling and use of materials
 - e. Proper use of tools and equipment
 - f. Housekeeping after completion of test
 - g. Safety precautions
3. Candidates should study the drawings and specifications attached to the test paper, if any, before the test begins.
4. Candidates should carry out the test according to test papers, working drawings and specifications provided.
5. Candidates should bring their own safety shoes and appropriate workwear, other safety equipment will be provided by HKCITTC. Candidates must take all necessary safety precautions to ensure work safety.
6. All tools and materials required by the test will be provided by HKCITTC, candidates should check and ensure their adequacy and quality. All the tools must be returned to HKCITTC after the test. The candidates may ask the invigilator for any problems.
7. Candidates are required to handle and move the tools and materials for use in the test, and to carry out associated work.
8. All candidates must stop when time is up.
9. Candidates are required to return the test paper to invigilator after the test.
10. Invigilators will take record photos periodically during the test.
11. Candidates are not allowed to take any photo or video with cameras or mobile phones.
12. Candidates are not allowed to use their mobile phones during the trade tests, except for in an emergency.
13. Offering bribes to an invigilator is an offence in law and HKCITTC will report to the ICAC for any such case.
14. Subject to certain situations and/or conditions of the date of event, trade tests/courses could be at any moment suspended or postponed at discretion of the invigilators. Examples of such situation/condition could be, but not limited to, (a) sudden operation disruptions to classrooms, test venues, test equipment or tools etc. due to unforeseeable mishaps; (b) sickness or injury of candidates, students or elated staff of the HKCITTC; (c) adverse weather conditions. HKCITTC will rearrange another appointment, for free, with the candidates/students affected. Whilst every effort is made to ensure the smooth running of trade test/courses, the HKCITTC will not resume any liability any loss/damage directly or indirectly related to such arrangement.

In the event that the candidate fails to take any necessary safety precautions and / or works in any dangerous situations, he / she will be deemed failed.
