3.1. Course objectives

Absolute beginner course for students to let them introduce to the basic Hungarian. The vocabulary and grammar is appropriate to level A.1.1.

3.2. Course contents

Students will be able to read and understand simple sentences, they can also form questions and answers.

At the end of the semester, they can talk about themselves, about their family and their country, and they can express themselves in simple, everyday situations such as shopping, restaurants, etc.

Vocabulary includes words and expressions used in daily life, such as meals, fruits, greeting schemes, short introduction, numbers etc. Students will understand the basic vocabulary for level A.1.1, and fundamental expressions of conversation in their close environment related to specific objects or issues, provided discussion runs slowly and plainly. Students will be able to read simple sentences, and raise and answer plain questions. They will be able to express their basic necessities, write a few sentences about themselves, and also fill in formulas asking for personal data such as name, address, and nationality.
