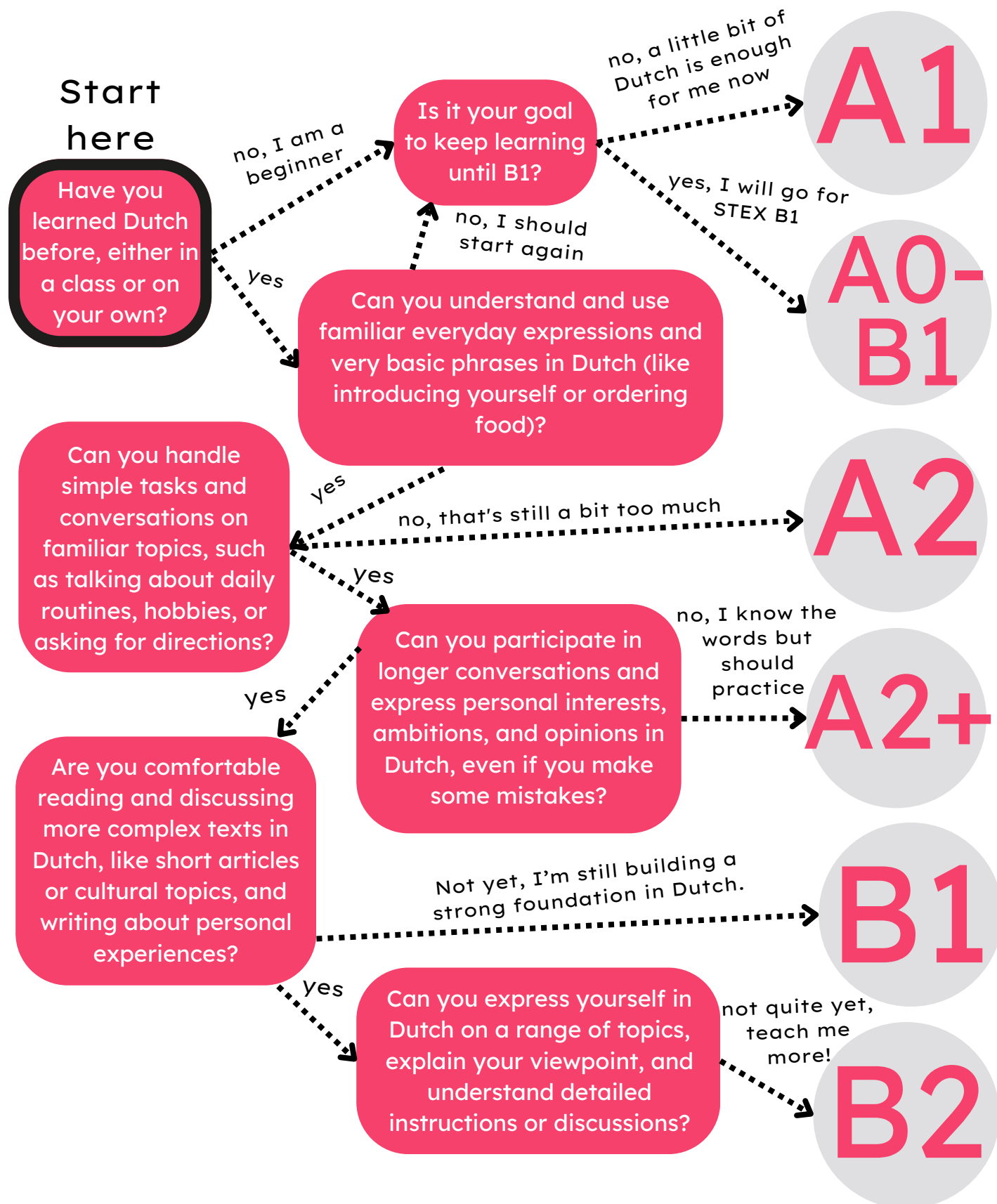
Overview of Courses

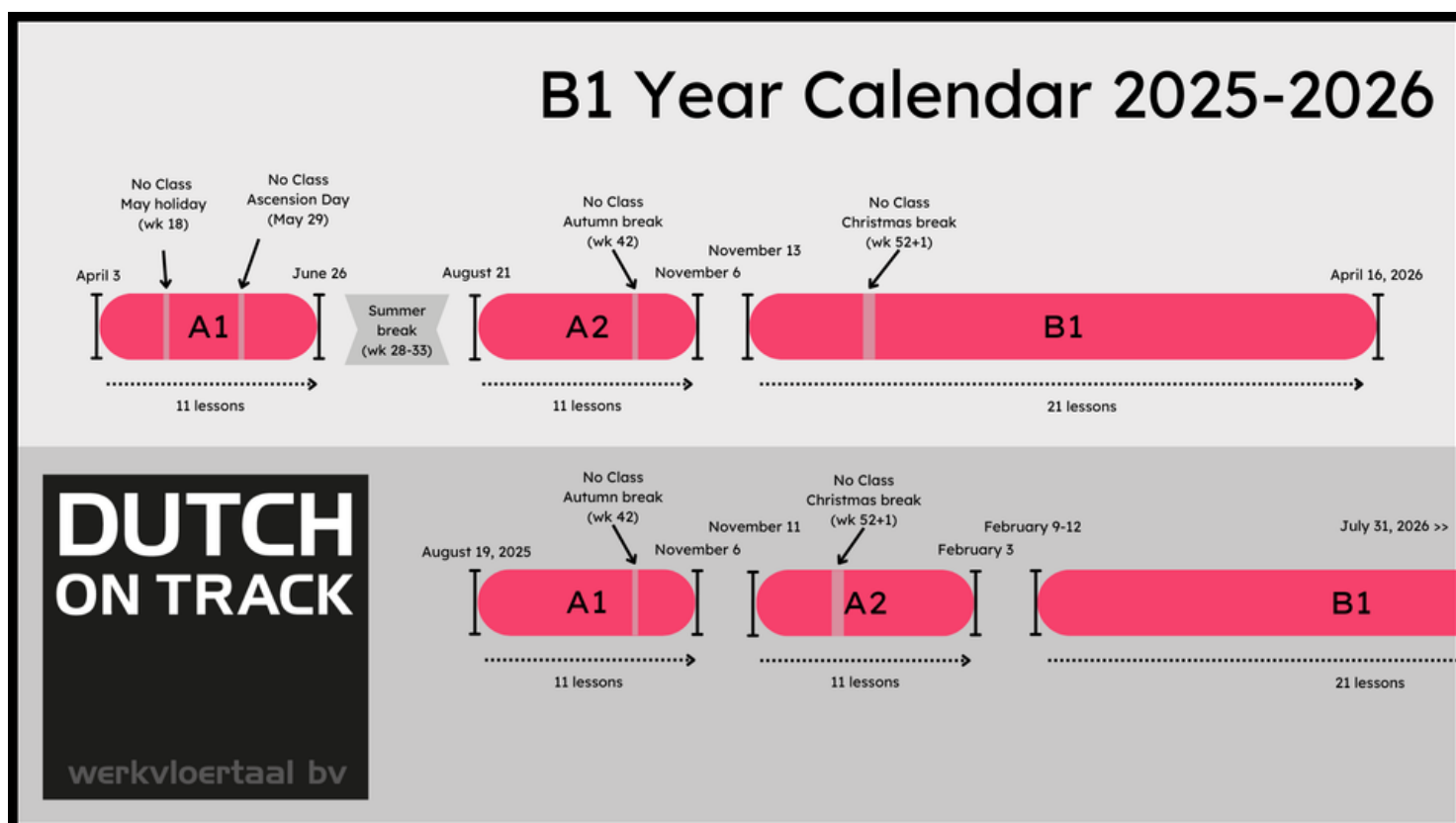
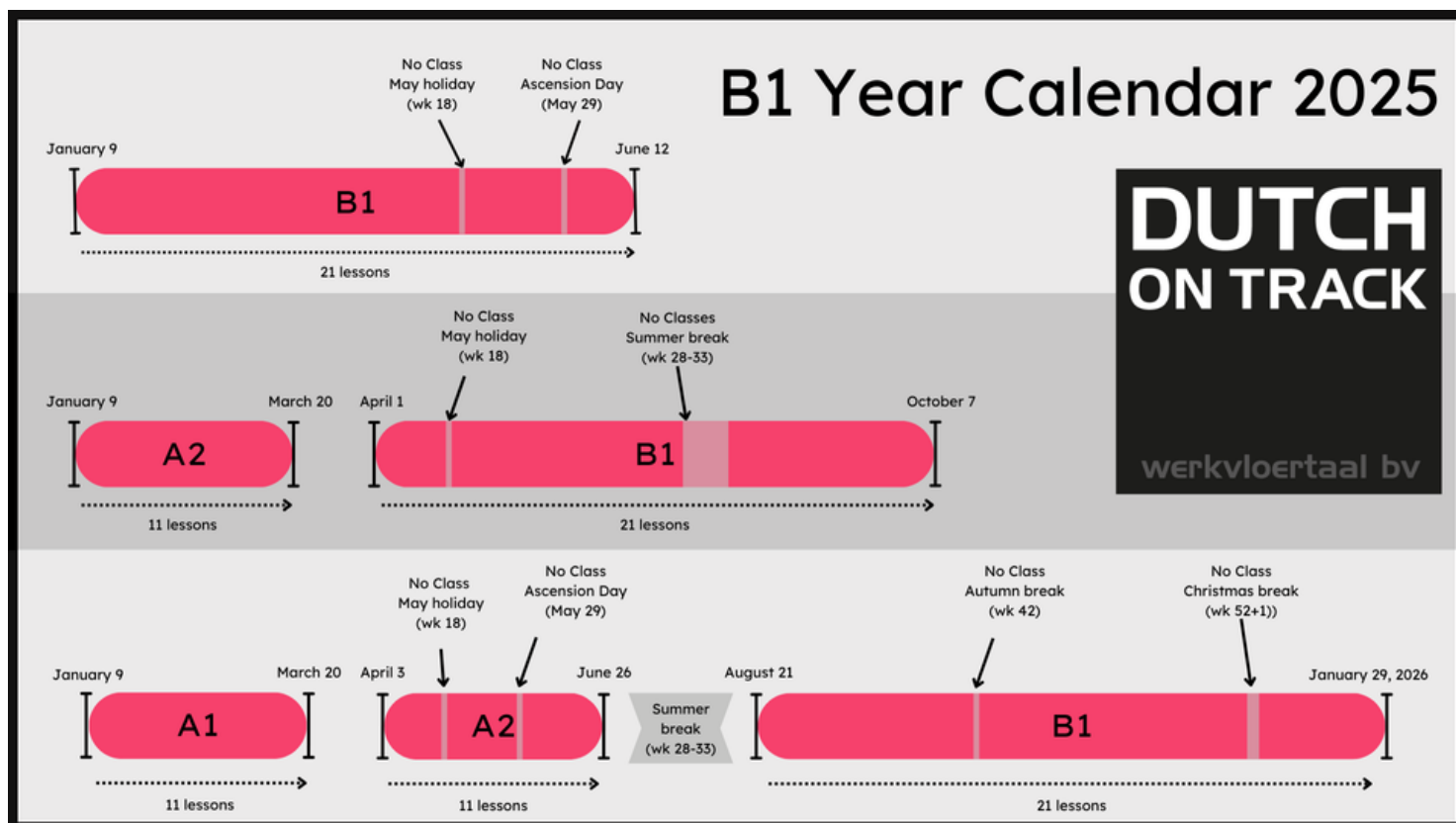

Methods

Frequently Asked Questions

For who is Dutch on Track?

Our courses are designed for expats, spouses, and highly educated internationals living in the Netherlands who want to learn Dutch. A good understanding of English is required for following the instructions in the course materials and for the initial beginner classes. As this is a fast-track program, it's important to have a strong educational background to keep up with the course's accelerated pace.

How many students are there in class?

We have a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 10 students in class.

Where are the classes held?

Our classes are offered both in-person at our location on Pastoor Petersstraat 162 in Eindhoven and online via Zoom.

Can I use a DUO loan for this course?

In some cases, yes. For example, if you are a migrant due to marriage, you may be eligible to use a DUO loan.

Can I ask my employer to finance this course?

Yes, many of our students have their courses sponsored by their employers. Speak to your HR manager to see if they're willing to support your Dutch language journey or if you can access your company's training budget.

Frequently Asked Questions

Does Dutch on Track prepare me for the integration exams?

Our primary focus is on building your Dutch language skills. While our A1 and A2 courses emphasize practical, everyday Dutch, our B1 course is specifically designed to prepare you for the official Staatsexamen B1. Achieving B1 level will be essential for naturalization in the future, though the exact date for this requirement hasn't been confirmed. We recommend starting B1-level training early to be well-prepared when this rule takes effect.

Do I need to provide proof of my current level, like official test results?

No, we trust you to select the course level that best suits your current skills. If you're unsure, we're always available to help you decide. You're also welcome to challenge yourself by aiming for a slightly higher level if you feel ready for it, or choose for a lower level if you feel that you need some repetition. As our courses are designed for highly educated learners, we trust that you'll be able to keep up and progress smoothly.

Course terms and conditions

Commitment to Learning

Learning a language requires time, dedication, and regular practice in real-life situations—whether at home, in the supermarket, or with neighbors. Homework expectations vary depending on the course level: around 6 hours per week for A0 to A1 and up to 12 hours for higher levels.

Missed lessons cannot be rescheduled or refunded, but you may request access to the learning materials for any missed classes. All study materials and homework will be provided by your teacher, and a certificate of participation will be awarded if you attend at least 80% of the lessons.

Course Fees and Payment Terms

- A0 to B1 Course Package: €1786.50
- Individual A1 or A2 Course: €500
- Individual A2+ conversation training: €360
- Individual B1 Course: €985

Your registration is confirmed once the course fees are paid in full before the course start. Late payments may result in cancellation of your registration.

Cancellation Policy

Each course requires a minimum of 8 students. If Dutch on Track cancels or reschedules the course, you will be informed at least three working days in advance and will receive a full refund within 14 days. If you cancel within 14 days of signing up (and before the course start), you are entitled to a full refund, in line with NRTO guidelines.

Course Structure and Multi-Level Enrollment Conditions

The A0 to B1 program is organized into three stages (A0-A1, A1-A2, and A2-B1). Enrolling in the full course package provides a complete learning path, yet you may choose to withdraw at the end of each level. Refunds are based on the portion of the course completed:

- After A0-A1: 40% of the full package fee is refundable.
- After A1-A2: 20% of the full package fee is refundable.

Withdrawal requests must be submitted in writing two weeks before the next level begins.

Course Duration and Termination

Dutch on Track reserves the right to terminate a course early if attendance is insufficient or other operational needs arise. In such cases, a proportional refund will be issued. If you leave the course voluntarily, no refund will be given.
