Short course description:	To develop communicative linguistic competence, which includes linguistic, pragmatic, and sociolinguistic components through reception (listening and reading comprehension), production and interaction (speaking and writing), and mediation (translation) linguistic activities at the intermediate level (B2) of Russian.
Course content:	Students acquire competence in advanced (C1) Russian language level through linguistic activities of reception (listening and reading comprehension), production and interaction (speaking and writing) and mediation (translation). Students will become familiar with all the registers of the Russian language (journalistic, office language, scientific, literary, and colloquial) to cope with complex communication situations, both written and oral, improving their language skills through oral presentation, discussions and the analysis of linguistic and presentation strategies. Special attention will be paid to the use of figurative, metaphorical, and idiomatic expressions of the Russian language. A mixed form of studies is used: group work, role-plays, dialogues, text analysis, work in MOODLE virtual environment (synchronous/asynchronous consultations, discussion forums, interactive tasks), independent work, practical application of theoretical material.
